## Retired batsman(not out)

Draw a pencil line against batsman's innings so that it can be rubbed out if the batsman returns from injury or suspension

Fall of wicket box split the fall of wicket box to show batsman has retired not out and that the fall of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ wicket actually falls when batsman no 5 is out
